

The figures in the emblem of The Christian and Missionary Alliance represent the centrality of Christ in a fourfold manner.



The cross stands for salvation through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, God' Son.



The laver represents sanctification, a daily cleansing from sin by the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit.



The pitcher speaks of oil, a symbol of divine life and physical healing that come through obedience to god's word.



The crown symbolizes the return to earth of the Lord Jesus Christ as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.
